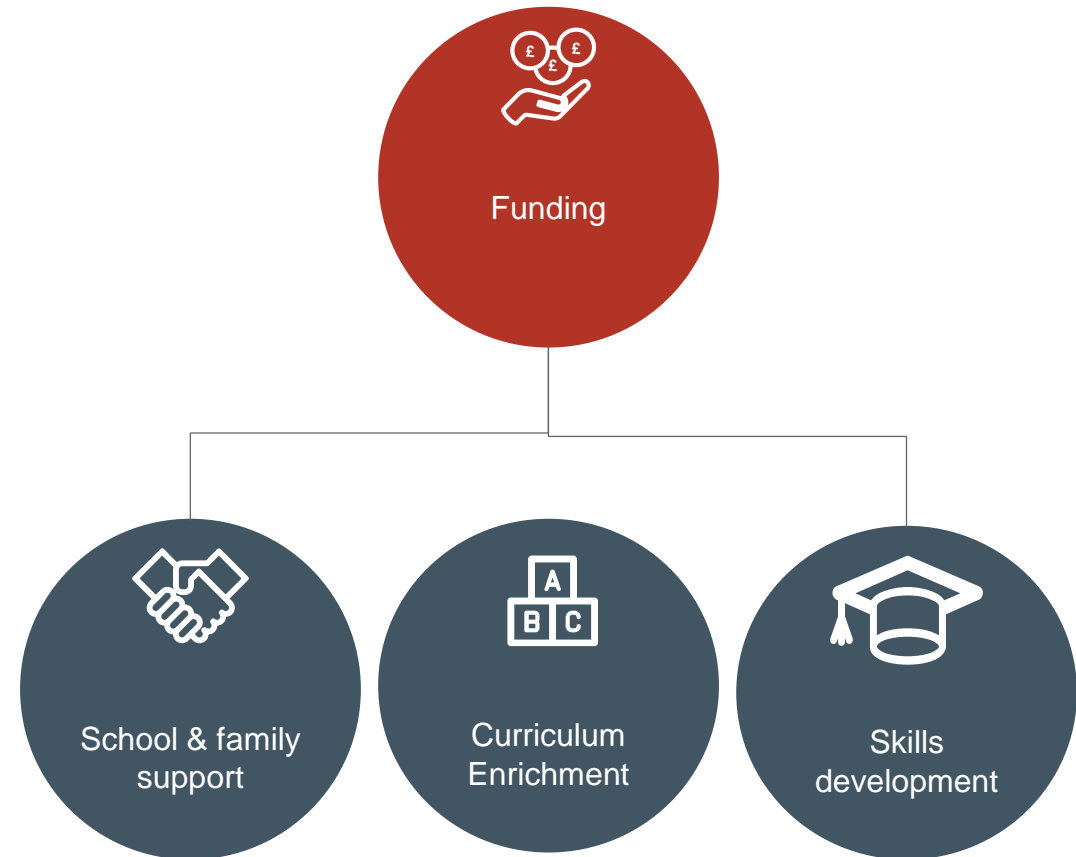

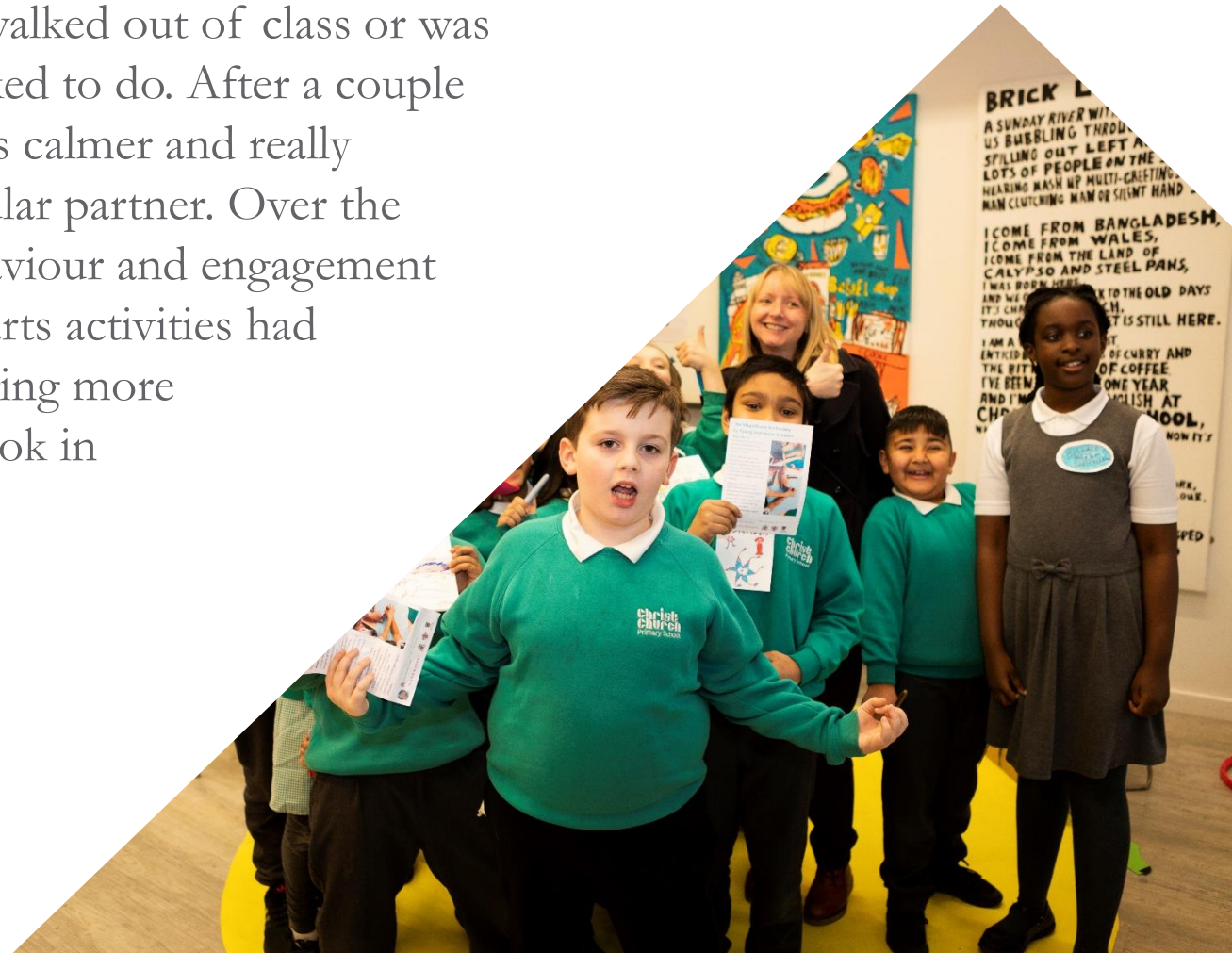

Inter-generational projects

“One child had really struggled with school and often walked out of class or was disruptive when he couldn’t cope with what he was asked to do. After a couple of the sessions with the artists and older people he was calmer and really engaged with the activities and one older man, his regular partner. Over the term this transferred to a real improvement in his behaviour and engagement in the classroom too. The teacher recognised that the arts activities had been an important part of this change, so is now bringing more creative tasks into learning across the curriculum to hook in those children who can struggle.”
